## What is Direct Share?

Direct Share is a monthly giving plan that provides an effective and secure way for you to send regular donations to PWS&D through a pre-authorized monthly withdrawal from your bank account or credit card.

You can make a real difference in the lives of people around the world while exercising good stewardship and commitment to development and relief programs through PWS&D.

## The Benefits of Monthly Giving:

- Overseas partners can rely on your regular, consistent support to carry out their programs.
- Pre-authorized withdrawals are free, so there's no need to worry about writing monthly cheques or paying for postage.
- Electronic donations help keep administrative costs low, enabling us to use your gifts as effectively as possible.
- You can still make offerings for special appeals and on special occasions such as Christmas, without affecting your monthly giving.



## It's Easy!

1. Complete the authorization form on the back of this page and mail it to PWS&D with a void cheque or your credit card information. Withdrawals will occur on the 20th of each month after your specified start date.
2. You can designate, modify or cancel your donation, or change your banking information with PWS&D at any time, subject to providing 15 days of advance notice.
3. You will receive one annual tax receipt for the total of your monthly contributions.

- I waive my right to receive pre-notification of the amount of the pre-authorized remittance and agree that I do not require advance notice of the amount of the pre-authorized remittance before the debit is processed.
