This trip offers a unique opportunity to work with and learn from Canada's aboriginal communities.



The team will fly to Saskatoon, SK and then drive up to Mistawasis. Mistawasis, meaning "big child", is a native community in which Mistawasis Memorial Presbyterian Church is situated. There, the team will assist the congregation and community with leading a day camp for the children of Mistawasis.
